- Relax in the lobby with a **Board Game, Puzzle, or Book**
- Work out in the **Fitness Center** located in the Administration Building
- Play a game at the **Indoor Basketball Court** in the Administration Building
- Stretch out in the **Yoga Room** in the Administration Building
- Visit the **Arcade** featuring two lanes of **Candlepin Bowling** (you set the pins), a **Billiards** table, a **Ping Pong** table, a **Foosball** table, and vintage **Pinball** games
- Explore the **Pebble Beaches and Coves** on the island
- Discover the **History** of our island on a self-guided **Walking Tour**, look for signs with QR Codes along the way in front of historic landmarks and structures.
- **Hike** trails and dirt roads around the island, **Nature-Watch** for eagles, seals, osprey, herons, and loons that are frequently seen along the shore.
- Rent a **Fat Tire Bike** at the front desk to explore the area
- Watch the boats in the cove from the **Moon Garden** overlook
- Take in a colorful sunset at **Sunset Park**
- Visit the **Ice Pond** and hunt for fairies at the fairy gardens
- Stroll through the **Art Gallery & Fort McKinley Historic Museum** (Appointment Suggested)
