



Parking in Portland is provided through the Unified Parking Partners Island Valet service and is a cost of \$40 per night, billed through your reservation with us here at the inn. Vehicles are accepted at 75 Commercial Street. This is across the street from The Casco Bay Lines ferry terminal and RiRa Restaurant. When you arrive, inform the attendant that you will be using the Island Valet service and will be staying with us at the Inn at Diamond Cove, they will accept your vehicle and provide you with a claim ticket. Oversized vehicles, motorcycles and handicapped vehicles will require special accommodation, please call ahead to make arrangements. Casco Bay Lines ferry terminal is just across the street, the valet will have a GEM car and provide transportation if desired.

Transportation to the island is typically by Casco Bay Lines ferry. The ferry schedule is available at [CascoBayLines.com](http://CascoBayLines.com). Tickets are available for purchase at the ticketing window inside the terminal, ask for tickets to Diamond Cove and ask what gate to board at. Please be sure to depart the ferry at Diamond Cove, not Great Diamond Island. It costs about \$11.00 per person round-trip, and tickets are collected only at the Portland mainland terminal when boarding.

If the ferry schedule will not work with your schedule, a number of water taxis are also available in Casco Bay. We typically recommend Portland Express Water Taxi ([ExpressWaterTaxi.com](http://ExpressWaterTaxi.com), 207-415-8493) or Atlantic Water Taxi ([AtlanticWaterTaxi.com](http://AtlanticWaterTaxi.com), 207-776-0017), both of which typically cost \$70 (up to six passengers) for one-way service to or from the Cove during daylight hours, with additional cost to operate at night.

Once you know what time your ferry or boat will be departing Portland, please give us a call here at the inn at (207)805-9836, and we will ensure that one of our drivers meets you at the Diamond Cove pier when you pull in. Once on the island you and your belongings will be brought up to the inn to check in. We have island maps available for all of our guests which indicate many points of interest around Diamond Cove – six private beaches, two picnic areas, the administration building with a fitness center and basketball court, the recreational building with a two-lane duckpin bowling alley and a small arcade, the Fort McKinley Museum, and the art gallery. There are also two restaurants, our lobby restaurant and Diamond's Edge (reservations strongly recommended), and the General Store for easy grab-and-go food. Right at the inn you will enjoy time spent in the pool and hot tub, sipping drinks by the fire pit, or cozying up to the lobby fireplace for a night of board games and coffee.
